



The majority of permission slips are available online. You can apply for and receive permission from home without coming to a Hunter Management Areas check station! The online application will be available beginning **July 12, 2011.**

You must bring the following information to obtain permission from a Hunter Management Check Station:

- **Hunting license or a clear photocopy** (not just the numbers). It is required that we see the actual hunting license.

- **Vehicle information**

If you are picking up a permission slip for a friend or relative, you must have a photocopy of their hunting license (or the original) and all vehicle information. (NOTE: Does not apply to Broom Creek, Soldier Creek and Ft Phil Kearney- you must appear in person with a photo ID.)

There is only one location for check stations this year for the Cody HMA's – They include: Absaroka Front, Carter Mountain, Copper Mountain, Deep Creek, Heart Mountain, Kirby Creek, Little V-H, Pitchfork & Upper Nowood.

HMA Station: Cody Regional Office, Hwy 120 on south edge of Cody.

Dates: August 31 (9a-4p), September 30 (9a-4p), October 31 (9a-4p), November 30 (9a-4p).
