

Application Checklist

We encourage you to apply online at <http://gf.state.wy.us> using your credit or debit card. However, if you prefer to submit paper applications, please refer to the checklist below to ensure that your application is completed correctly.

- 1. Verify the application form number is the same as the one indicated on the map and charts for the species and type for which you wish to apply.
- 2. If you are applying as a party, did you complete the party application block?
Did all applicants (limit six) fill out the applications in the same manner (same species, area, type and order of preference)?
Did you include all applications in one envelope?
- 3. **COMPLETE THE NAME, SPORTSPERSON IDENTIFICATION NUMBER, MAILING ADDRESS AND PHYSICAL ADDRESS PORTION OF THE APPLICATION.**
- 4. List your **DATE OF BIRTH.**
- 5. Include your **TELEPHONE NUMBER.** This may enable clarification of a questionable application.
- 6. Have you or your representative signed the application? Representatives should sign their own signature for the applicant name.
Example: John Doe for John Smith. (John Doe is the Representative for John Smith.)
- 7. Submit the proper fee payable to Wyoming Game and Fish Department.
- 8. Thoroughly review the current species hunt area maps to ensure your desired hunt areas and types are properly completed for the sex of the animal and season date of your choice.
- 9. Address your envelope properly and mail to: Wyoming Game and Fish Department, License Draw Section, 5400 Bishop Blvd., Cheyenne, WY 82006-0001.
- 10. **MAKE A COPY OF YOUR APPLICATION FOR YOUR RECORDS.**
- 11. Mail your application early in the application period to allow time for checking and to make corrections if necessary.

- Each person licensed to hunt or fish in Wyoming, except those hunting or fishing on daily licenses, must purchase a Conservation Stamp prior to going into the field.
