Hunter Management Area (HMA)

is a block of private land that has been enrolled for public hunting access. Hunters must receive permission from the Department prior to entering the HMA. See Department Web site for a list of current HMA's, information about each one and how to obtain permission. HMA's are only open during specific dates and for specific species.

Walk-In Hunting Area (WIA)

is a block of private land enrolled for public hunting access. Hunters do not need to ask permission. Simply locate the area using a WIA atlas or Department Web site and walk on in. WIA's are only open during specific dates for specific species. Be sure to read and follow rules and regulations provided in atlas.
