

Wolf Report
For the week ending June 20, 2008

The state of Wyoming officially assumed management authority for wolves on March 28, 2008. This report covers the period from June 14 through June 20.

Wolf Research

Nothing new this week.

Wolf Monitoring

Wyoming Game and Fish Department personnel continue to closely monitor wolves and wolf activity throughout northwest Wyoming.

Reported Wolf Kills

Four wolves killed by USDA Wildlife Services as the result of the following depredation investigations.

Depredation Investigations

On June 17 WGFD personnel confirmed a yearling heifer killed on private property by wolves from the Carter Mountain Pack. WGFD requested assistance from USDA Wildlife Services and two adult wolves were removed on the same afternoon as the depredation. The control action is complete and we will work closely with the cattle producer to minimize any further depredations.

On June 19 WGFD personnel confirmed a calf killed on private property by wolves from the Absaroka Pack, west of Cody. WGFD requested Wildlife Services to remove two wolves. Control actions were completed the following morning when two adult wolves were killed near the depredation site. We will work closely with the cattle producer to minimize any further depredations.
