

Wolf Report
For the week ending July 11, 2008

The state of Wyoming officially assumed management authority for wolves on March 28, 2008. This report covers the period from July 5 through July 11, 2008.

Reported Wolf Kills

In the Predatory Animal area, USDA-Wildlife Services removed one adult male wolf in the upper Hoback Drainage in response to domestic sheep depredations.

Monitoring

Department personnel are conducting routine summer trapping and radio collaring in the following areas:

Wolf Management Specialist Ken Mills is trapping and collaring in the upper Green River drainage.

Wolf Management Specialist Bob Trebelcock is trapping and collaring in the Sheridan Creek drainage near Togwotee Pass.

Wolf Management Specialist Scott Becker is trapping and collaring in the South Fork and Greybull River areas.
