s. Youth with Life Threatening Illnesses. The Commission may issue up to twenty-five (25) Antelope licenses, twenty-five (25) Deer licenses, twenty-five (25) Elk licenses and twenty-five (25) Turkey licenses each year for the exclusive distribution by nonprofit charitable organizations for use by persons twenty (20) years of age or younger with life threatening illnesses.

How To Apply For a Big Game License

There are no General Antelope Licenses.

Antelope licenses are all Limited Quota licenses.

How to apply for a Limited Quota Antelope license for a Combined Hunt Area:

Limited Quota Antelope licenses can be either Full Price or Reduced Price. Use Form 19 to apply for Full Price licenses and/or Reduced Price Doe/Fawn Antelope licenses. **EXAMPLE:** You want to hunt Any Antelope in areas 97 and 117. Three combined Limited Quota Antelope licenses are offered for areas 97 and 117. One combined license is a Type 1 for Any Antelope beginning on Sept. 17. The others are a Type 6 and Type 7 for Reduced Price Doe/Fawn Antelope. To apply for the Any Antelope license in this combined area, place 097 (the first hunt area in the combination) in the area box and place 1 in the type box on Form 19. The license will be issued as an "Antelope license" and will list hunt areas 97 and 117.

Correct Example of Applying for a Combined Hunt Area:

First Choice Area <u>097</u> Type <u>1</u>	Second Choice Area ____ Type ____	Third Choice Area ____ Type ____
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Just place the first hunt area and preferred type of the combined hunt area on your application. You may indicate a second or third choice on your application.

Incorrect Examples of Applying for a Combined Hunt Area:

First Choice Area <u>97 & 117</u> Type <u>1</u>	Second Choice Area <u>97, 117</u> Type ____	Third Choice Area <u>117</u> Type <u>1</u>
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DO NOT list all the hunt areas for the combined hunt area; just list the first hunt area. **DO NOT** list second or third area of the combined areas.

How to apply for a Limited Quota Antelope license for a Specific Hunt Area:

Limited Quota Antelope licenses can be either Full Price or Reduced Price. Use Form 19 to apply for Full Price licenses and/or Reduced Price Doe/Fawn Antelope licenses. Example: You want to hunt Reduced Price Doe/Fawn Antelope in area 50. Three different Limited Quota Antelope licenses are offered for area 50. Type 1 is for Any Antelope beginning on Sept. 16; Type 0 is for Any Antelope, muzzle-loading firearms only beginning Sept. 1; and Type 6 is for Reduced Price Doe/Fawn Antelope beginning Sept. 16. To apply for the Reduced Price Doe/Fawn Antelope license (Type 6), place 050 in the area box and place 6 in the type box on Form 19.

Correct Example of Applying for a Specific Hunt Area:

First Choice Area <u>050</u> Type <u>6</u>	Second Choice Area ____ Type ____	Third Choice Area ____ Type ____
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Just place the specific hunt area you want to hunt in the area box and place the appropriate type in the type box for the license limitation you want.

Incorrect Examples of Applying for a Specific Hunt Area:

First Choice Area <u>050</u> Type ____	Second Choice Area <u>050</u> Type <u>8</u>	Third Choice Area <u>050</u> Type <u>1</u>
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DO NOT leave the type box blank; you must place the type for the limitation you want. **DO NOT** put an invalid type number on your application. Make sure the type number is a valid choice on the tentative season charts for this hunt area and license type.

How to apply for a Region General Deer License:

Region General Deer licenses are Full Price licenses. Form 18 must be used. **EXAMPLE:** You plan to hunt in area 11, but want the option to hunt in other nearby areas with a general season. Four different Limited Quota Deer licenses are offered in area 11. Area 11 has a Region General license (Region B) season for Antlered Deer beginning Oct. 1. Area 11 also has a Limited Quota license for Any White-Tailed Deer beginning Oct. 1 (Type 3); a Limited Quota License for Reduced Price Doe/Fawn Deer beginning Oct. 1 (Type 6); and Reduced Price Doe/Fawn White-Tailed Deer beginning Oct. 1 (Type 8). To apply for the Region General License for Region B, place “B” in the area box and leave the type box blank on Form 18. The license will be issued as a “Region B General Deer license” and can be used in area 11 and any other hunt area in Region B offering a General license season.

Correct Example of Applying for a General License:

First Choice Area B Type ____	Second Choice Area ____ Type ____	Third Choice Area ____ Type ____
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Just place the Region Letter “B” in the area box and leave the type box blank. You may indicate a second or third choice on your application.

Incorrect Examples of Applying for a General License:

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When applying for a Region General license, **DO NOT** put a type on your application. Leave the type box blank. Also, **DO NOT** list the specific hunt area you want to hunt. **DO NOT** add the initial R G for Region General.

How to apply for a Limited Quota Deer license for a Combined Hunt Area:

Limited Quota Deer licenses can be either Full Price or Reduced Price. Use Form 18 to apply for Full Price licenses and/or Reduced Price Doe/Fawn Deer licenses. **EXAMPLE:** You want to hunt any Deer in areas 157 and 170. Four different combined Limited Quota Deer licenses are offered for areas 157 and 170. Type 1 is for Any Deer beginning on Oct. 1; Type 3 is for Any White-Tailed Deer beginning Nov. 1; Type 6 is for Reduced Price Doe/Fawn Deer beginning Oct. 1; and Type 8 is for Reduced Price Doe/Fawn White-Tailed Deer beginning Oct. 1. To apply for the Any Deer license in this combined area, place 157 (the first hunt area of the combination) in the area box and place 1 in the type box on Form 18. The license will be issued as a “Deer license” and will list hunt areas 157 and 170.

How to apply for a Limited Quota Deer license for a Specific Hunt Area:

Limited Quota Deer licenses can be either Full Price or Reduced Price. Use Form 18 to apply for Full Price licenses and/or Reduced Price Doe/Fawn Deer licenses. **EXAMPLE:** You want to hunt any White-Tailed Deer in area 120. Four different Limited Quota Deer licenses are offered for area 120. Type 1 is for Any Deer beginning on Nov. 1; Type 3 is for Any White-Tailed Deer beginning Nov. 15; Type 6 is for Reduced Price Doe/Fawn Deer beginning Sept. 15; and Type 8 is for Reduced Price Doe/Fawn White-tailed Deer beginning Oct. 1. To apply for the Any White-Tailed Deer license (Type 3), place 120 in the area box and place 3 in the type box on Form 18.

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Just place the specific hunt area you want to hunt in the area box and place the appropriate type in the type box for the license limitation you want. You may indicate a second or third choice on your application.

How to apply for a General Elk license:

General Elk licenses are Full Price licenses. Form 17 must be used. **EXAMPLE:** You plan to hunt in area 28, but want the option to hunt in other areas offering a general season. Area 28 has a General license season for Any Elk beginning October 1. Area 28 also has a Limited Quota license for Antlerless Elk beginning October 23 (Type 4). To apply for the General license, place “GEN” in the area box and leave the type box blank on Form 17. The license will be issued as “General Elk license” and can be used in hunt area 28 and any other hunt area offering a General license season.

Correct Example of Applying for a General License:

First Choice Area <u>GEN</u> Type <u> </u>	Second Choice Area <u> </u> Type <u> </u>	Third Choice Area <u> </u> Type <u> </u>
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Just place “GEN” in the area box and leave the type box blank.

Incorrect Examples of Applying for a General License:

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When applying for a General license, **DO NOT** put a type on your application. Leave the type box blank. Also, **DO NOT** list the specific hunt area you want to hunt.

How to apply for a Limited Quota Elk license for a Combined Hunt Area:

Limited Quota Elk licenses can be either Full Price or Reduced Price. Use Form 17 to apply for Full Price licenses and/or Reduced Price Cow/Calf Elk licenses. **EXAMPLE:** You want to hunt Any Elk during the rifle season in areas 41 and 42. Three different combined Limited Quota Elk licenses are offered for areas 41 and 42. Type 1 is for Any Elk beginning Oct. 15; Type 4 is for Antlerless Elk beginning Oct. 15; and Type 9 is for Any Elk, Archery hunting only beginning Sept. 1. To apply for the Any Elk license in this combined area, place 041 (the first hunt area listed in the combination) in the area box and place 1 in the type box on Form 17. If drawn, the license will be issued as an “Elk license” and will list hunt areas 41 and 42.

Limited Quota Elk licenses can be either Full Price or Reduced Price Elk licenses. Use Form 17 to apply for Full Price licenses and/or Reduced Price Cow/Calf Elk licenses. **EXAMPLE:** You want to hunt Reduced Price Cow/Calf Elk in area 23. Three different Limited Quota Elk licenses are offered for area 23. Type 1 is for Any Elk beginning Oct. 1; Type 4 is for Antlerless Elk beginning Oct. 1; and Type 6 is for Reduced Price Cow/Calf Elk beginning Oct. 1. To apply for the Reduced Price Cow/Calf Elk license (Type 6), place 023 in the area box and place 6 in the type box on Form 17 in the bottom section entitled “Reduced Price Cow/Calf Elk License.”
