

# Application Checklist

*We encourage you to apply using the WGFD website, using your credit or debit card. However, if you prefer to submit paper applications, please refer to the checklist below to ensure that your application is completed correctly.*

- 1. Verify the application form number is the same as the one indicated on the map and charts for the species and type for which you wish to apply.
- 2. If you are applying as a party, did you complete the party application block? Did all applicants (limit six) fill out the applications in the same manner (same species, area, type and order of preference)? Did you include all applications in one envelope?
- 3. **COMPLETE THE NAME, SPORTSPERSON IDENTIFICATION NUMBER, SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, MAILING ADDRESS AND PHYSICAL ADDRESS PORTION OF THE APPLICATION.**
- 4. List your **DATE OF BIRTH.**
- 5. Provide **PROOF OF RESIDENCY** as well as **YEARS RESIDENCY.**
- 6. Include your **DAYTIME TELEPHONE NUMBER.** This may enable clarification of a questionable application.
- 7. Did you sign the application?
- 8. Submit the proper fee payable to Wyoming Game and Fish Department.
- 9. Thoroughly review the current species hunt area maps to ensure your desired hunt areas and types are properly completed for the sex of the animal and season date of your choice.
- 10. Address your envelope properly and mail to: Wyoming Game and Fish Department, License Draw Section, 5400 Bishop Blvd., Cheyenne, WY 82006-0001.
- 11. **MAKE A COPY OF YOUR APPLICATION FOR YOUR RECORDS.**
- 12. Mail your application early in the application period to allow time for checking and correction if necessary.

- Each person licensed to hunt or fish in Wyoming must purchase a Conservation Stamp prior to going into the field. See page 42 for Conservation Stamp Requirements and Exemptions.
- Purchase Conservation Stamps on the WGFD website.
