INSTRUCTIONS: Prior to filling out the application, please check the Chapter 10 regulation for the types of wildlife that can and cannot be possessed, imported, confined, transported, disposed of, or sold. Complete the application according to each line's request (all lines must be completed). If one line does not apply, write N/A in that space. Include the **common name and scientific genus and species** for each type of wildlife being requested to possess, import, dispose of, sell or transport. Up to a maximum of 100 game birds in aggregate can be held for dog/falcon training purposes and the specific number of game birds by species are not required to be specified. The application must be **SUBMITTED TO YOUR LOCAL GAME WARDEN. The game warden must approve and sign the application before a permit will be issued.**

If a permit is issued for importation, the permittee shall obtain the appropriate certificate of veterinary inspection prior to importation, satisfying the requirements of Appendix I or II of Chapter 10 of the Wyoming Game and Fish Commission Regulations.
