### **Confirmed Grizzly Bear Killed Livestock**

- Nothing to report for this period. One calf was killed on private lands near Dubois on April 13, 2011 that has not been previously reported.

- Captured and relocated an adult male grizzly bear for frequenting calving pastures and residential areas near Meeteetse.

- Taught bear safety to a Cody area hunter education class.
- Ten "Staying Safe in Bear, Lion and Wolf Country" seminars were conducted in ten Wyoming communities this spring. These seminars are well received and have been integral to the Department's outreach efforts. Nearly 300 people attended the seminars.
