### **Confirmed Grizzly Bear Killed Livestock and Agriculture Damage**

- Verified one bear killed and one bear injured yearling heifer on a Forest Service grazing allotment west of Meeteetse.
- Verified one bear killed calf near Pass Creek in the Wyoming Range.
- Verified two bear killed calves on a Forest Service grazing allotment north of Pinedale.

### **Monitoring and Research**

- Completed data analysis for upcoming Yellowstone Ecosystem Subcommittee meeting.
- Picked up dropped radio collars on Klondike Hill and New Fork Canyon.

### **Bear Management (Captures, Relocations and Removals)**
